

## PROMOS

The "Programme to Increase the Mobility of Students from German Universities" (Programm zur Steigerung der Mobilität von Studierenden deutscher Hochschulen – PROMOS) is funded by the Federal Ministry of Education and Research.

### Eligible for funding are:

- Obligatory internships abroad (6 weeks to 6 months)
- Study and research stays as well as final theses abroad (1 to 6 months).

### Requirements:

- Enrolment at the HSWT (in a Bachelor's or Master's degree programme)
- German citizenship (foreign students can receive the scholarship if they are treated as Germans according to § 8 BAföG)
- A letter of acceptance from the company or the university is required
- Good knowledge of the national or business language
- Good academic performance and convincing motivation
- The period of study abroad must be credited to the degree programme.
- There must not be a travel warning issued by the Federal Foreign Office for the region in question.

### Scholarship benefits:

- Partial scholarship\* (if applicable, only for part of the stay)
- Travel allowance\*
- Subsidy towards the tuition fees at a host university

\*The amount depends on the destination country. If you receive Auslands-BAföG, €300 of the partial scholarship per month will not be deducted. Amounts in excess of this will be offset against the benefits of the Auslands-BAföG. If a flat-rate travel allowance is granted, the travel allowance of the Auslands-BAföG does not apply.

### Application and deadlines:

#### Application deadlines

- for stays in the summer semester: January
- for stays in the winter semester: June
