

Accepted certificates as proof of language skills for the Master International Farm Management

Applicants for the Master International Farm Management who cannot provide evidence of an English-language bachelor's degree, an equivalent English-language academic first degree or a relevant university entrance qualification at an English-speaking educational institution must demonstrate knowledge of the English language at the minimum of level B2 in accordance with the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages. The following certificates are accepted as proof of language skills:

- TOEFL: Test of English as a Foreign Language:
Required minimum level: internet based test min. 72 points
- TOEIC: Test of English for international Communication:
Required minimum level: Listening min. 400 points, Reading min. 450 points
- IELTS: International English Testing System:
Required minimum level: IELTS Academic min. 5,5 points
- TELC English:
Required minimum level: B2 Scholl, Business or Technical
- ESOL Cambridge university: English for Speakers of Other Languages:
Required minimum level:
 - Cambridge English: First (FCE)
 - Certificate in English Language Skills: Vantage
 - Cambridge English: Business Vantage
- CET: College English Test:
Required minimum level: Band 6
- Pearson PTE Academic:
min. 59 points
- UNIcert®-Zertifikat
Level II Englisch or higher
- German "(Fach-)Abiturzeugnis", if it explicitly certifies knowledge of the English language at language level B2 or higher.

Proof is provided by presenting the respective certificate or attestation, the grade sheet or other evidence (e.g. university entrance qualification in the relevant language) that is equivalent to those already mentioned. The examination committee of the language centre of the university decides on the equivalence of other evidence.
